1) Pan Africa e Network Project

Pan Africa e-Network Project was launched in 2009 to create significant linkages for tele education, tele medicine, communication and VVIP connectivity in 54 African countries. However, 48 countries signed agreements. M/s TCIL is the implementing agency for the project. The local project cost of Rs.542 crores is being met by MEA. Expenditure till date is Rs.395.19 crores.

2) Technical Assistance Programme (TAP) for Development of the Cotton Sector in African countries.

This technical assistance programme was launched under 2nd India Africa Forum Summit held in 2011 to provide technical assistance to cotton sector in Cotton 4 countries (Benin, Burkina Faso, Mali and Chad) as India's commitment at WTO, Geneva. Aat present six countries, viz Benin, Burkina Faso, Chad, Nigeria, Malawi and Uganda are covered under this programme. Mali was left out due to volatile security situation there. Department of Commerce is the nodal agency and IL&FS Cluster Management is Project management Agency (PMA) for this Programme. The approved budget for the programme is Rs.21 crores. A total of Rs. 12 crores has been released to PMA till date.

3) India Ghana Kofi Anna Centres for Excellence in ICT at Accra

Govt. of India extended a grant of Rs.385.30 lakh to the Govt. of Ghana to support India Ghana Kofi Annan Centre for Excellence in ICT at Accra to promote development of IT in Ghana. The project has been implemented by the Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC) since March 2011. So far Rs.292.41 has been released.
