The High Commission of India organized live webcast of inauguration of Pravasi Bharatiya Kendra (Centre for Indian diaspora) by the Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi on the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi on Oct 2, 2016. The Pravasi Bharatiya Kendra is dedicated to the Indian diaspora numbering more than 28 million and showcases the rich cultural heritage of Indian Diaspora from different parts of the world. The Kendra will host a wide range of activities such as meetings, seminars, classes and cultural events to facilitate exchange of ideas involving the Diaspora.

About 70 members of the Indian community in Brunei participated in the event. Shri Mohinder Singh Bhullar, a prominent person of Indian origin who was awarded Pravasi Bharatiya Samman in 2010, India's highest award to an Indian living overseas also attended the function. In his remarks, Shri Ravinder Nath, Acting High Commissioner, acknowledged the significant contribution made by the Indian diaspora in the countries of their residence while maintaining close cultural links with India. He also spoke about the forthcoming Pravasi Bharatiya Divas in Bengaluru in January 2017 and special programmes for the youth including Know India Programme.
