Please confirm	The service provider need not design any banner but once provided by the embassy, they have to appropriately link it to the relevant gallery/link in the website.

Service provider as the technical support entity is expected to help the embassy that the website is not hacked or intruded, if any such incident happens service provider will bring to the notice of embassy along with taking corrective action.
5	The Bidder must have experience in developing GIGW compliance Websites.	Shall we submit STQC certificate received or have to provide any specific letter?	The service provider need to provide an appropriate document clearly confirming their experience in developing government website as per GIGW.

6	The Agency must get at least 2 good references from Indian missions abroad.	What kind of documents has to be submitted?	The bidder need to send the URL of the websites maintained of two government departments/Ministries/Missions.
7	Annual Maintenance for 1 year has to be provided.	Server maintenance is also included in this maintenance? Please confirm	Yes, a combined quote for maintenance of website and server is to be provided.
8	As per Corrigendum, Point no. 10 - Database management (b) Maintain registered Indian citizen database	Mission do have some database which needs to be merged with futuristic data. – The existing database structures has to be defined for merging the database. Please advice or provide more information	The website has to be broadly as can be seen at our main website www.embassyofindiadakar.gov.in , which also has in the main message from the Ambassador cross links to the database driven asp pages(ex. Whatsnew, faqs link https://asp.embassyofindiadakar.gov.in/eoia/aFAQs_list.asp).
