## Press Release United in the Fight Against Terrorism All Party Delegation Visit to Copenhagen [29-31 May 2025]

An All-Party Parliamentary Delegation led by Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, is visiting Copenhagen from 29-31 May 2025 to convey India's unwavering stance against terrorism and its perpetrators.

- 2. Today, the delegation met H.E. Mr. Lars-Christian Brask, Hon'ble Deputy Speaker and Member of the Presidium of the Parliament; Chairman of the Foreign Policy Committee Mr. Christian Friis Bach, and other counterparts from the Danish Parliament. The delegation also met a group of former officials, Ministers, Members of Parliament and diplomat who carry influential voice in Denmark and abroad.

India's strong condemnation of the terror attack in Pahalgam and resolute action taken in the form of Operation Sindoor formed the focus of briefings given by the Indian delegation to the Danish side. It clarified that India's warranted response through 'Operation Sindoor' was diplomatically measured and commensurate.
- 4. The delegation emphasized on India's zero-tolerance towards terrorism and stance that any act of violence would be responded to befittingly. India's appreciation of Denmark's public stance condemning the Pahalgam terrorist attack and the expression of solidarity with India was conveyed to the Danish side during the meetings.
- 5. The delegation also met the local Indian diaspora in an interactive setting. Operation Sindoor's success and India's resolve to stand firm in our collective fight against terrorism were emphasized during the interaction.
