2. Only point no. 1 of your query pertains to the undersigned CPIO. Information with respect to point no. 1 is as follows:

The Government of India organized three special flights on 31 January 2020, 1 February 2020 and 26 February 2020 to evacuate 766 persons, which included 723 Indian nationals and 43 foreign nationals from the city of Wuhan as well as other cities of Hubei Province in China in view of the continuing lock down of the Hubei Province.

3. The information with respect to point no. 2, 3 & 4 of your query is not available with the undersigned CPIO and the same is being transferred to Ministry of Health & Family Welfare for necessary action at their end.

4. The information with respect to point no. 5 of your query is not available with the undersigned CPIO and the same is being transferred to Bureau of Immigration for necessary action at their end.

5. If you are aggrieved with this reply, you may file an appeal to Dr. Amit Telang, Director(East Asia) & Appellate Authority, Ministry of External Affairs, South Block, New Delhi -110001, within a month from the date of receipt of this letter.
