Kindly furnish the total number of such complaints where investigations were initiated against such Indian UN Peacekeepers, troops or employees. ALSO, MENTION the year such complaints were received and the year when investigations were initiated. Kindly mention for each year since THE YEAR 1990 TILL DATE.</li> <li>3. Kindly furnish the total number of such complaints where investigations were completed.</li> <li>4. Kindly furnish the total number of investigations that are still pending and since how long.</li> <li>5.
