- (b) Can travel by Air in Executive Class on the expeditions of Govt ~~and~~ and take their wife along with them on foreign tours.
- (c) Can draw further Gratuity on their completion of their terms as Chairman etc etc.
- (d) Can he is empowered to allow the Vacation/Leave at par with the officials of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India with full pay and allowances (i.e. Summer Vacation/Winter Leave) to the officer/staff of the Council to whom he is heading;
- (e) Can he is empowered to reduce the working hours of the officer/staff of the Council etc to whom he is heading with full pay & Allowances (i.e. allowing them to come late and go early by 1/2 an hour in the morning and 1/2 hour in the evening).
- (f) When he is allowed to contribute in C.P.F ^{only} on his ~~appointment~~ re-appointment as Chairman as per his term and condition set out by the Govt of India, is entitled to Employer's Contribution under the C.P.F Rules while drawing full pension from the Govt of India.
