JS (Health Ministry)

- 1. Active Case –11.12 % and Recovered cases- 87.76 % (today-22.05.2021).
- 2. Recovered cases are more than active cases.
- 3. Plateauing is observed in cases for the last 5 days.
- 4. There is a decrease in daily new cases and deaths.
- 5. There is a consistent increase in testing across the country.
- 6. There is a decrease in case positivity since last two weeks.
- 7. 8 States more than 1 lakh active cases-Karnataka, Maharashtra, Kerala, Rajasthan, and Tamil Nadu etc. 8 States have 50,000 to 1 lakh active cases and 20 States have less than 50,000 active cases.
- 8. 18 States have more than 15 % positivity Pondicherry, Goa, West Bengal, Lakshadweep, Kerala etc.
- 9. 14 States have 5 % to 15 % positivity.
- 10.4 States has less than 5 % positivity.
- 11. Total doses vaccinated 18.41crore (1st dose-14.12crore and 2nd dose 4.29crore) (for People aged above and equal to 45 years, Healthcare workers and Frontline workers).
- 12. There is a continued focus on decrease in vaccine wastage.
- 13. Action being taken to ramp up supply and availability of Amphotericin-B fungal drug. States advised towards the need for Infection Prevention & Control (IPC) to manage fungal infections in health facilities.
- 14. Countrywide 'AYUSH COVID-19 Counselling Helpline' is operationalized to provide guidance on AYUSH-based post COVID-19 rehabilitation and management.

- 15. In India, Covid pandemic is stabilizing now.
- 16.382 districts have more than 10 % positivity rate.
- 17. Children may acquire and spread Covid infection. There are minimal symptoms of Covid infection in children.
- 18. Children also have low motility rate from this infection.
- 19. Steroids should not be used irrationally.
